1 Post Graduate Diploma in Child Mental Health

Introducing the first postgraduate diploma in child mental health in the Kingdom in cooperation with Alfaisal University, Massachusetts General Hospital, and Sulaiman Olayan Foundation under the supervision of Dr. Lamis Al Saleem.

2 Creating specialized training packages

The Ministry of Education approved the training packages created in collaboration with the Voice of Down Syndrome Society (SAUT) based on international educational principles. The aim is to develop the capabilities of children with mental disabilities and train the educational and rehabilitation team.

3 Natural Language Development in Early Childhood Program

In collaboration with the Ministry of Human Resources and Social Development, a training program has been developed for caregivers and supervisors in nurseries. The aim is to recognize the natural development of language and communication in early childhood and describe the risk indicators of communication disorders. The training program is obligatory and available on Dorooob platform.

4 The first 1000 days of motherhood are the most important



An awareness campaign has been launched to raise societal awareness of the importance of the first 1000 days of a child's life. The campaign is being conducted on social media in partnership with Al Mawaddah Society for Family Development.

Developing the first Early Childhood Environment Standard: SASO-3055

In collaboration with the Saudi Standards, Metrology, and Quality Organization (SASO), an Early Childhood Environment Standard has been developed. The Standard is applicable to centers that offer learning and/or care for newborns to 8-year-old children.

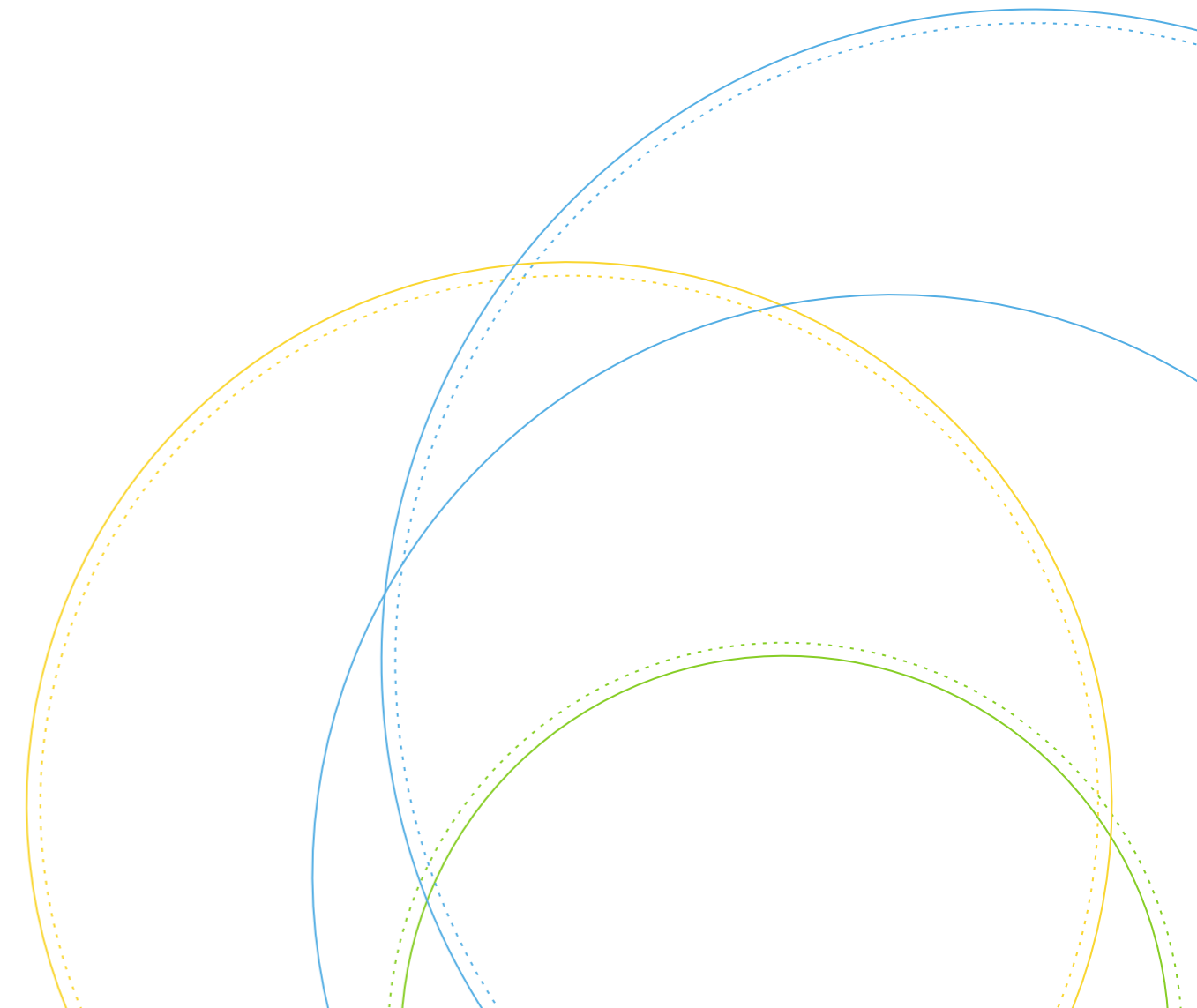
Conducting surveys to understand language disorders and promote the importance of early intervention

In partnership with international and local universities, and in collaboration with the best experts, surveys have been conducted to provide regular information about the prevalence of language disorders among children in Saudi Arabia and its impact on them. The results of those surveys will be utilized to influence legislation and practices related to early detection.

Conducting the first research study on the genomics of Down Syndrome

In collaboration with the King Salman Center for Disability Research, we conducted three research studies on the genomics of Down syndrome to enrich knowledge in the fields of prevention and comprehensive care. This effort helps address disability issues and achieve national goals.

2 Developmental Housing

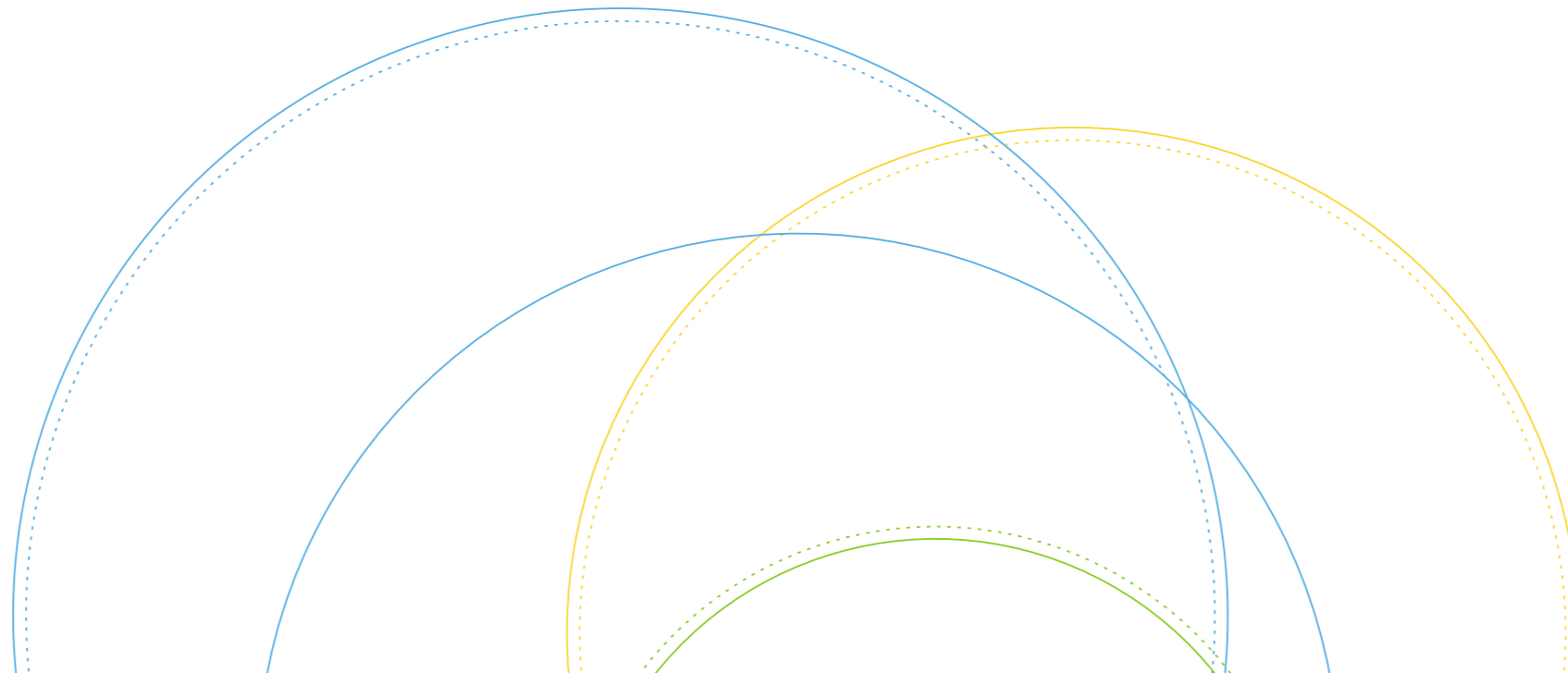
For a good life and stable environment
